## Make Way Partners FAQ

+ **Through the Hope of the Gospel, Make Way Partners goes to the most vulnerable and least protected to end human trafficking or modern day slavery through prevention.**

+ **How does Make Way Partners prevent human trafficking?**

By working with at-risk people in countries of origin, we seek to be the hands and feet of Christ to them by offering indigenous ministries of counseling, discipleship, education, employment, food, medical treatment, and shelter.

+ **How do we select places of ministry?**

We select places with two criteria:

- 1) Where women & children are at highest risk of human trafficking, forced prostitution and other forms of modern-day slavery.
- 2) Where little to no other help is available because it is considered either "too" dangerous, "too" expensive or "too" remote for most people to go.

+ **What has Make Way Partners done in Sudan?**

MWP is building an orphan-care network in the nation. We focus on orphans because they are the most vulnerable to human trafficking. We currently have orphan homes on the border or Darfur protecting nearly **500 children**. And have recently acquired 200 additional acres for additional orphan care development in the country!

With the **formerly enslaved women** we offer a slave repatriation and sponsorship program to help these women care for their families and receive healing after years of trauma. We train and employ many of these women through our indigenous ministry and micro-enterprise.

The partnership is also working to **rebuild the surrounding community** as we develop an indigenously run medical clinic, drill wells to provide clean water, and as we bring short term teams to encourage, disciple, and provide practical solutions to our brothers and sisters there in need.

+ **How are donations used?**

We strive to be good stewards of the resources we receive to provide ministry to the 'least of these'. **100% of all donations go directly to care for your sponsored child or children.** No administrative fees are taken out of these life-saving gifts. Because Make Way Partners is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization, donations are tax-deductible. Make Way Partners is accredited by ECFA (Evangelical Council of Financial Accountability), meeting the standards of responsible stewardship, including financial accountability, transparency and ethical fundraising.
